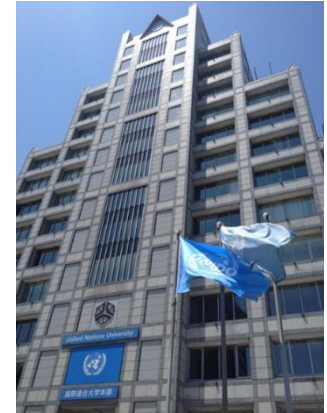

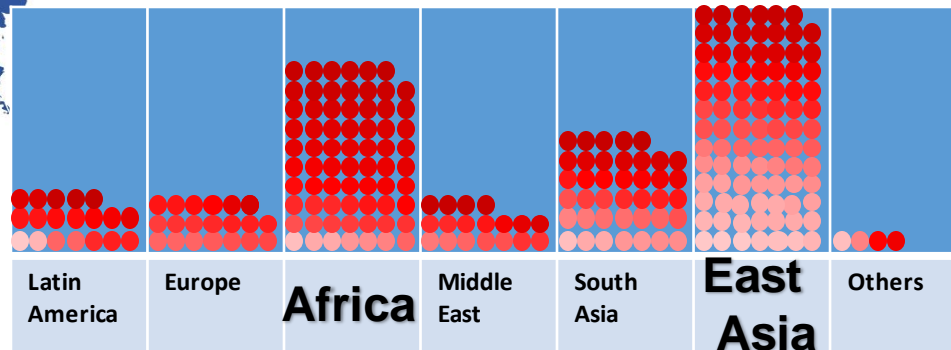

  5. Publication “UniWorld” and newsletters



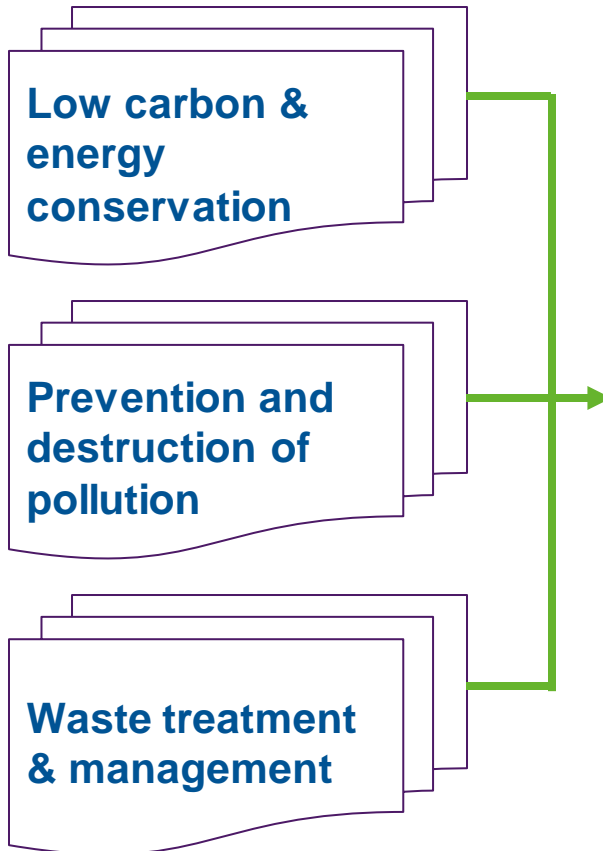
