Goal: establishment of organic products production through the introduction of innovative processes of organic agricultural production, the modernization of the food and food processing industry.


Projects:



Historically known as the "bread basket of Europe", Ukraine is focused on becoming the "food basket" of the world. With 33% of the world's black-earth soil concentrated in Ukraine, a favourable climate and proximity to key markets, Ukraine is becoming an agricultural export powerhouse.

Ukraine ranks 11th in Europe in certified land. In addition to agricultural lands, Ukraine has 530 thousand hectares of wild lands certified according to organic standards.

- Upgrading shipbuilding, aviation and rocket industries of Ukraine.


Area of interests – Transport
