





Number of cases per day, seven-day rolling average. Each country on its own scale













#### Mega Infrastructure Projects

Toward the completion of the s pecial economic zones dedicate d to Japan, the construction of t he metro rail covering the 8 ind ustrial districts (partly schedule d to start in 2021), construction of the Matarbari super supercritical pressure coal thermal power plant (to be completed in 2024), etc. Japanese companies will be expected to advance



#### Garments/leather Industries

Among export items of Banglad esh, clothing items account for about 80% and overwhelming s hare. Also, expanding transactio ns with developed countries that are exempt from tariffs by the generalized system of preference (GSP). As labor costs in Chin a are skyrocketing, more and more companies are considering enter in Bangladesh in search of cheaper and abundant human resources compared to China and other Asian countries.



#### Consumer Goods Business

Cosmetics, white goods home appliances, etc. ar e establishing local bran ds, there are many imported goods from China and India. Consumers tend to buy cheap products.



#### Medical Related Industries






