## ACHIEVEMENTS

- The final geotechnical investigation report was shared with the Ministry of Works and Transport (MoWT) for their review on February 1.
- UNIDO shared the ToR for the Technical Committee with MoWT for review and endorsement on February 1. The Permanent Secretary of MoWT has agreed in writing to the implementation of a TC, and promised to nominate the TC members shortly.
- MoWT and UNIDO reached out to all MoWT motor grader trainers and prepared a dedicated training on the GD663A-2 motor grader eLearning modules for them.
- The 2020 annual report was shared with project partners for their feedback.
- UNIDO met with representatives of the Nakawa Vocational Training Institute (NVTI) to share experiences on the curriculum accreditation process with the Directorate of Industrial Training (DIT).

## PLANNED ACTIVITIES IN MARCH 2021

- The first GD663A-2 motor grader e Learning will be held for all MoWT motor grader trainers on March 2 at Victoria Equipment in Kampala. The purpose of the training is to familiarize the trainers with the e Learning and collect feedback for the roll out for the operators in the districts.
- MoWT will reach out to other Ugandan institutions that are using the GD663A-2 motor grader to enable their operators to participate in the eLearning. These institutions include the Uganda National Roads Authority (UNRA), Kampala Capital City Authority (KCCA), and the National Enterprise Cooperation (NEC).
- MoWT will nominate its members of the Technical Committee, and the TC will be held for the first time.
- The revised and final 2020 annual report will be shared with all project partners.
- UNIDO will meet with representatives from Uganda Technical College Lira (UTC-Lira) to learn about their upcoming highway construction program and potential synergies with the project.
