Project for Development of the Construction Equipment Operator Training Centre

ACHIEVEMENTS

- UNIDO signed a contract with the successful engineering designs vendor. The MoWT-UNIDO Technical Committee (TC) has been informed about the progress and a TC meeting will be convened in time to launch the process.
- The training for the 50 Ministry of Works and Transport (MoWT) trainers was rolled out in the first week of November, starting with the health & safety training.
- The health & safety training was successfully completed at the Central Mechanical Workshop (CMW) Kampala on November 3 as well as the Regional Mechanical Workshops (RMWs) in Bugembe on November 4, Gulu on November 16, and Mbarara on November 18. According to the anonymous feedback forms, 87% of the participants rated the training overall as either good or excellent and 100% of the participants rated the course content as either good or excellent.
- The textbooks for the theoretical training were distributed in all four training locations after the health & safety training. The first theory training assignments were shared by the master trainer with the CMW Kampala group.
- The procurement of a Toyota Coaster minibus with 30 seats for METRAC was finalized by UNIDO, with an expected delivery in Q2 of 2022.

PLANNED ACTIVITIES IN DECEMBER 2021

- The 4th TC meeting for METRAC will be held to launch the engineering designs process together with the vendor, Arch Design Ltd. Another follow-up TC meeting will be held ideally before the end of the year to review the initial master plan and preliminary designs.
- MoWT will arrange a secure room at their premises where the simulator training can take place while METRAC is being constructed. 4 Komatsu WorksiteVR Simulators are currently waiting for deployment in the MoWT.stores.
