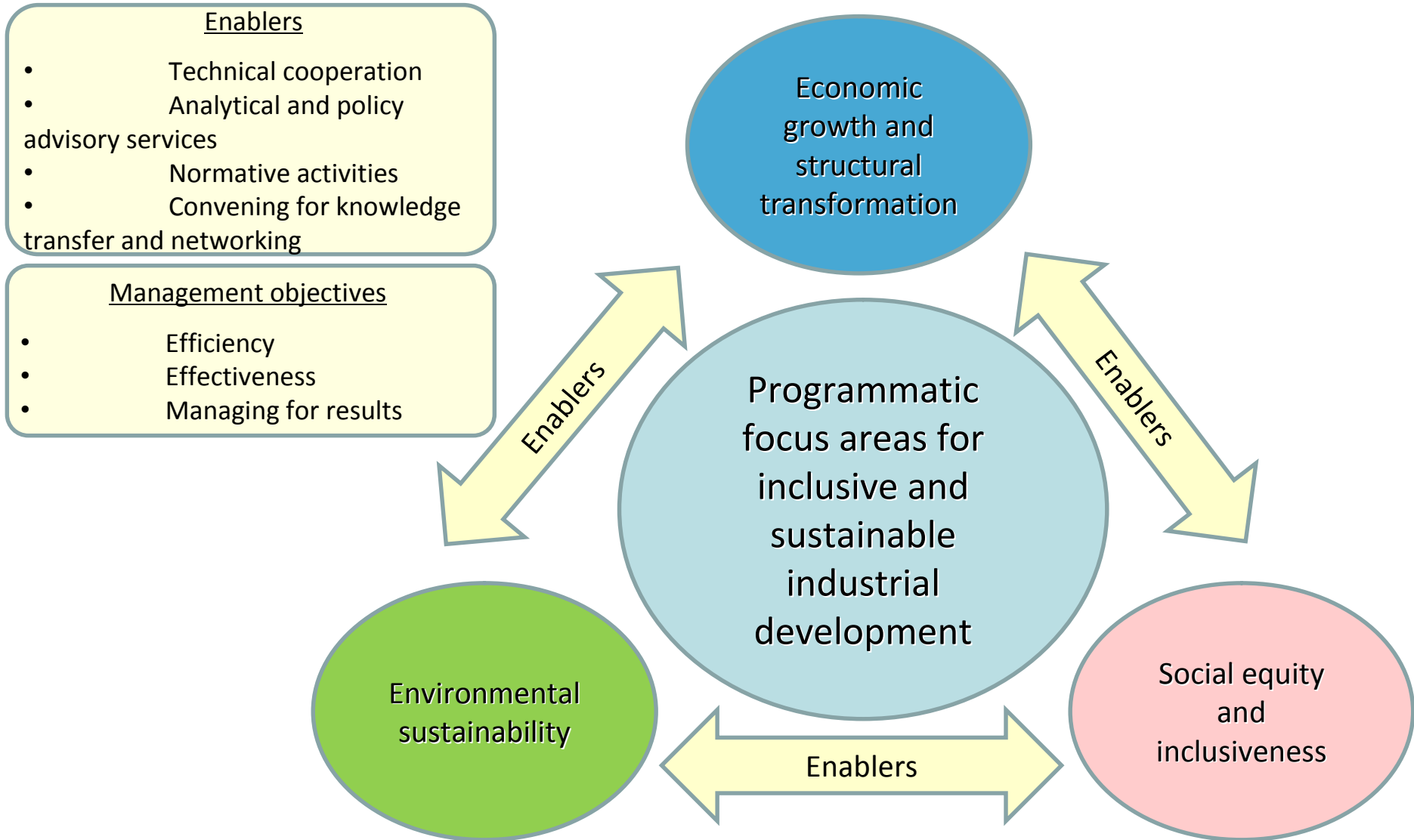
UNIDO

We want every country to have the opportunity to grow a flourishing productive sector, to increase their participation in international trade and to safeguard their environment.

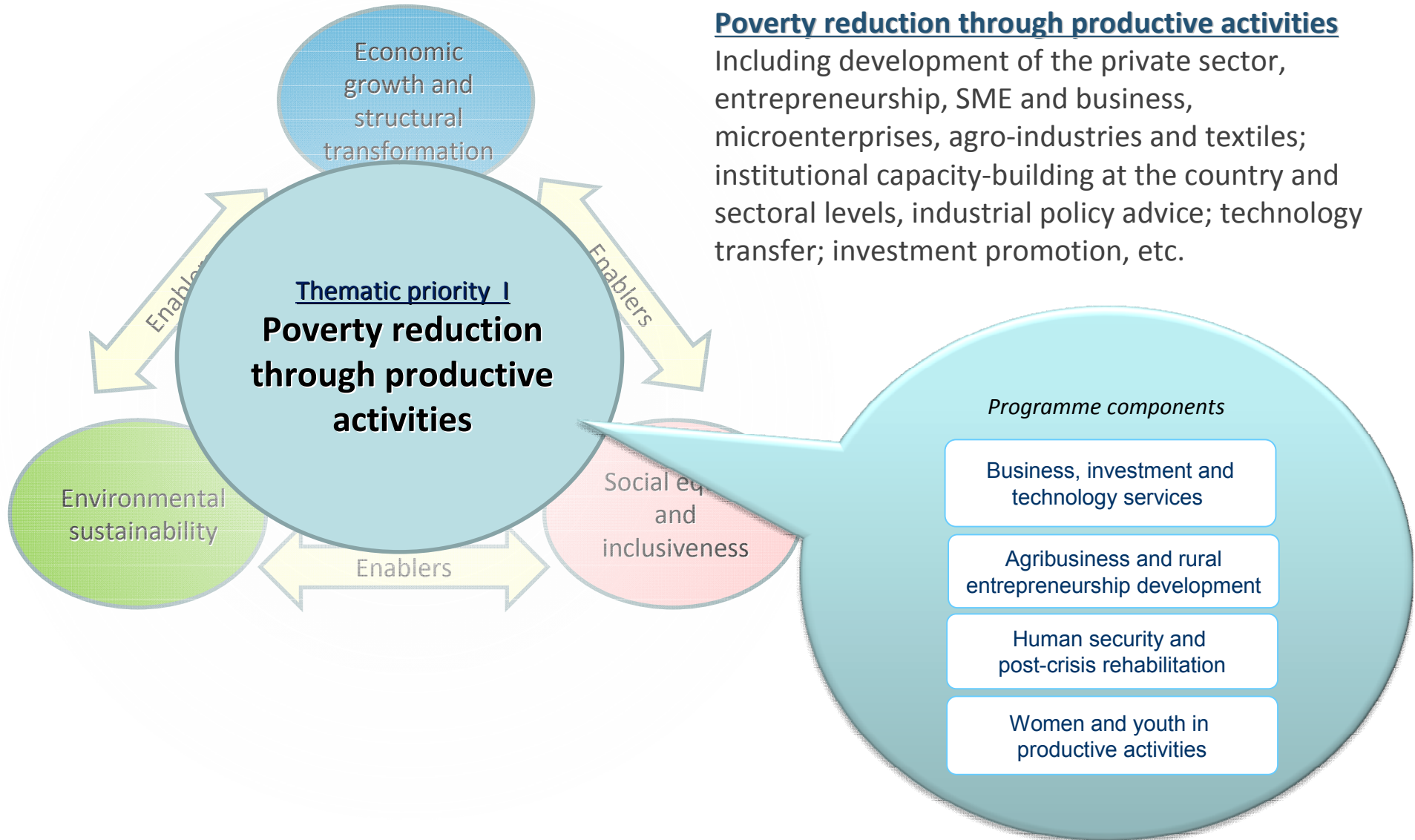




Agribusiness

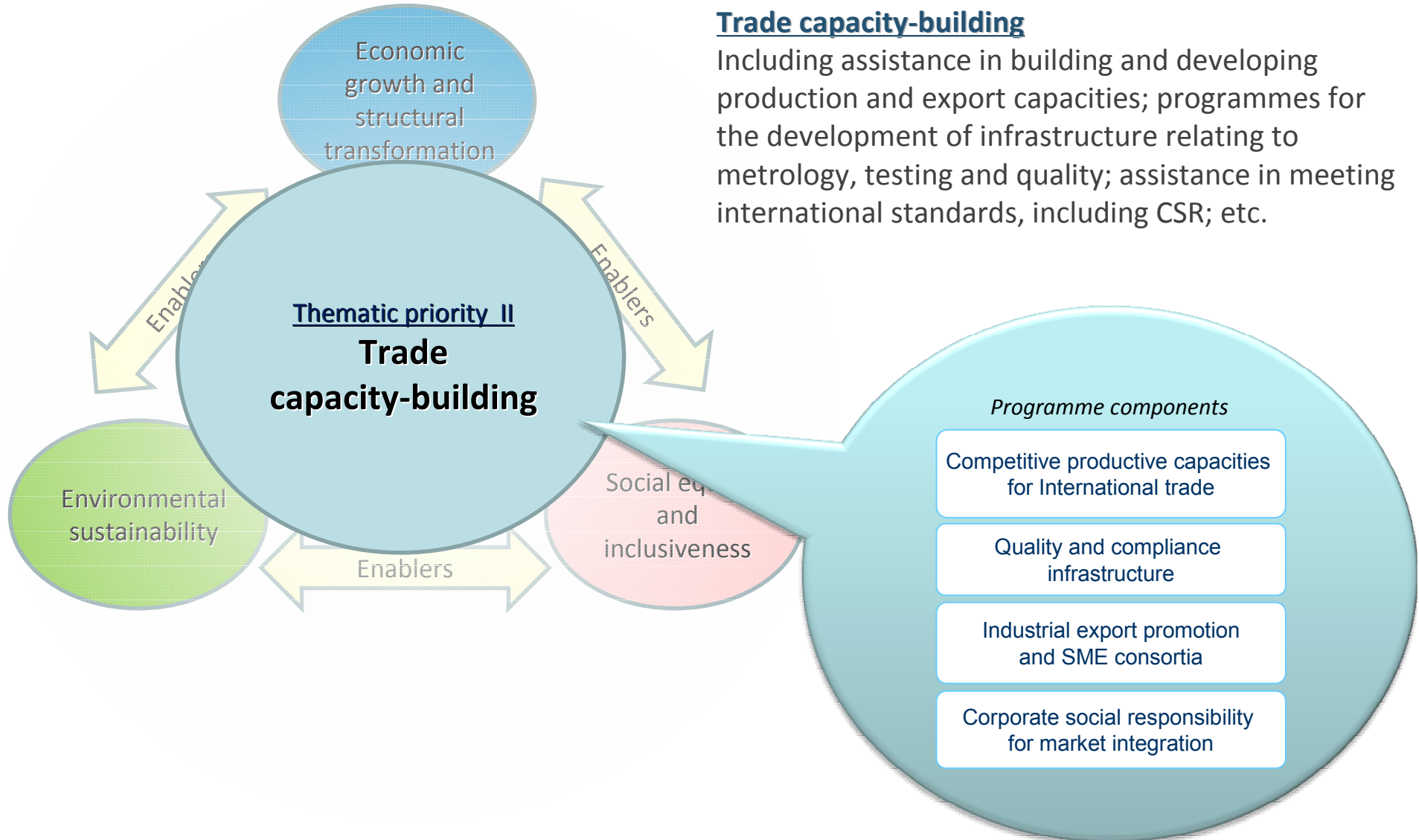
- Fundamental for structural transformation, increased value-addition and food security

- Sustainable supplier development partnership initiated with METRO Group; further partnerships with AEON, Auchan Group, Migros and Walmart under negotiation.





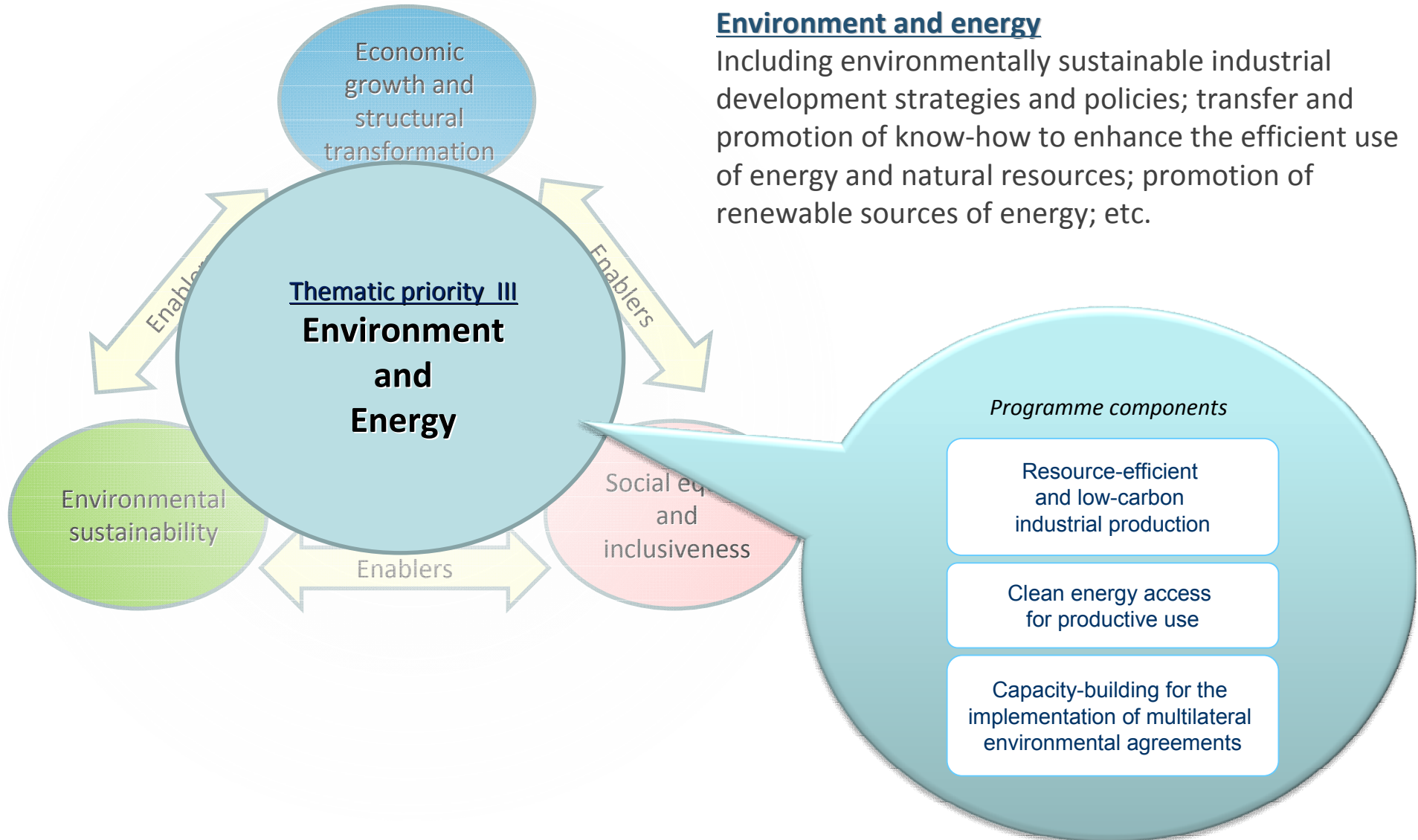
Poverty reduction through productive activities

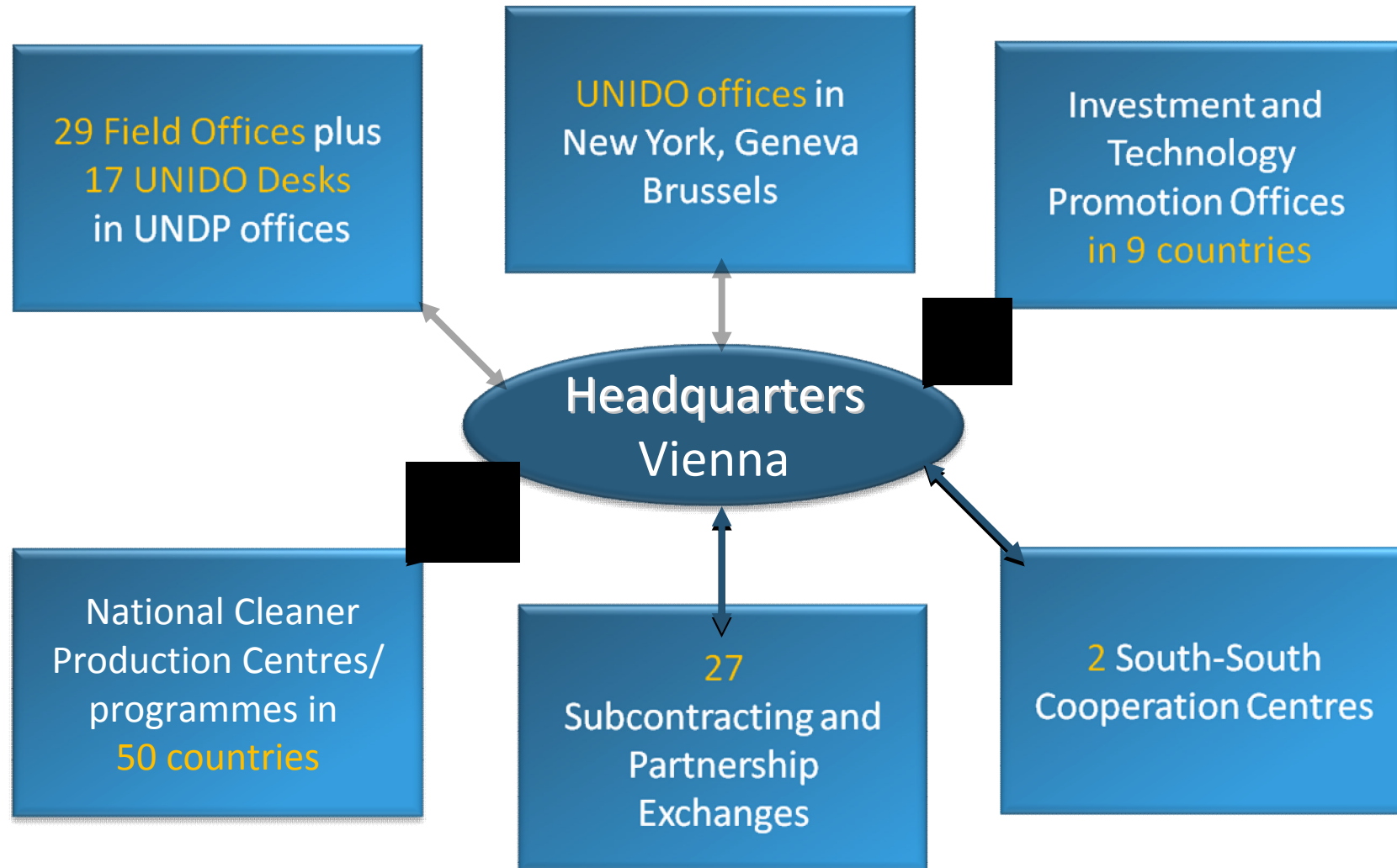
Trade capacity-building

Including assistance in building and developing production and export capacities; programmes for the development of infrastructure relating to metrology, testing and quality; assistance in meeting international standards, including CSR; etc.



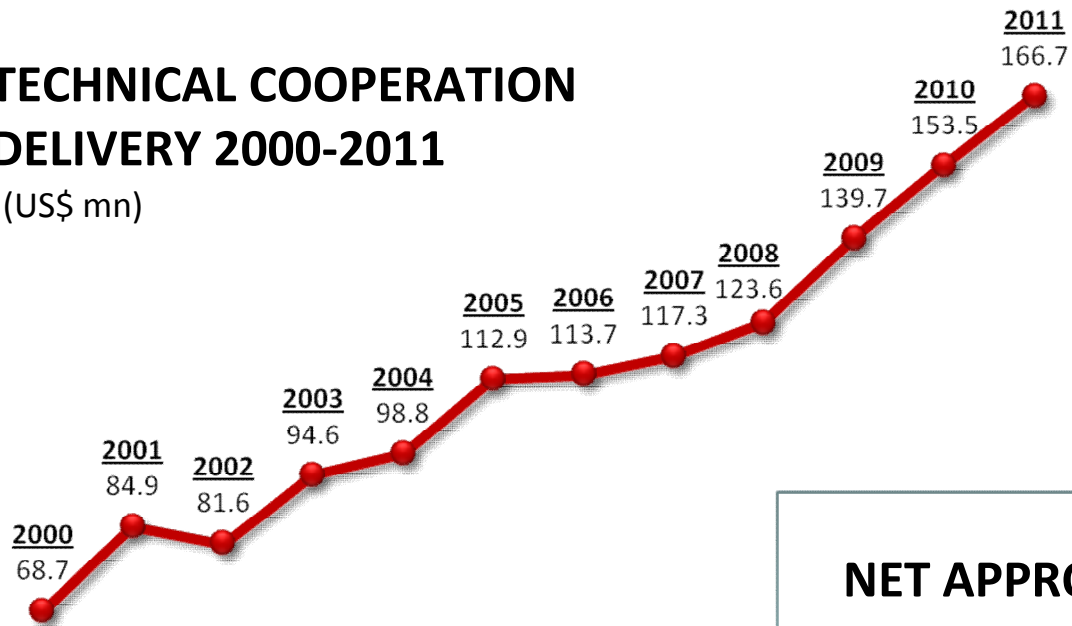
Environment and energy

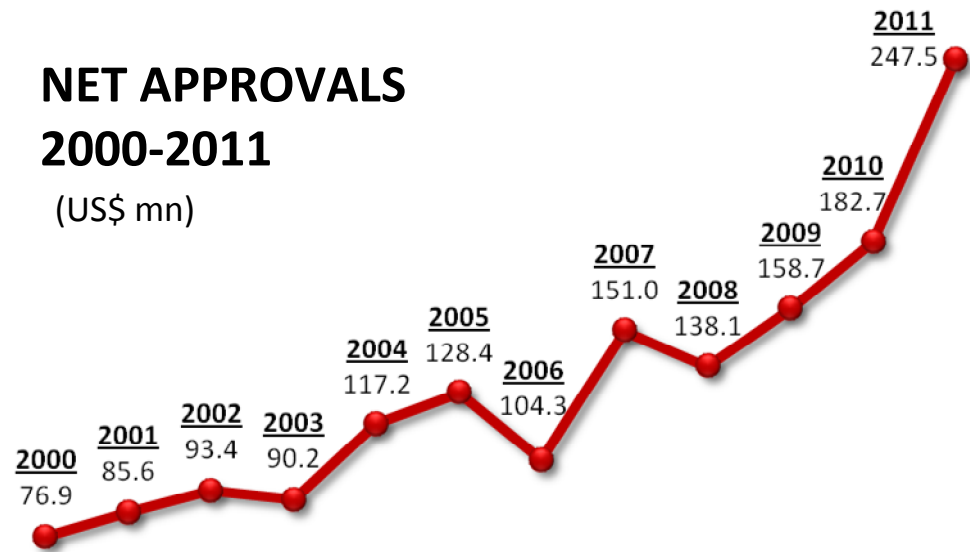




TECHNICAL COOPERATION DELIVERY 2000-2011 (US\$ mn)

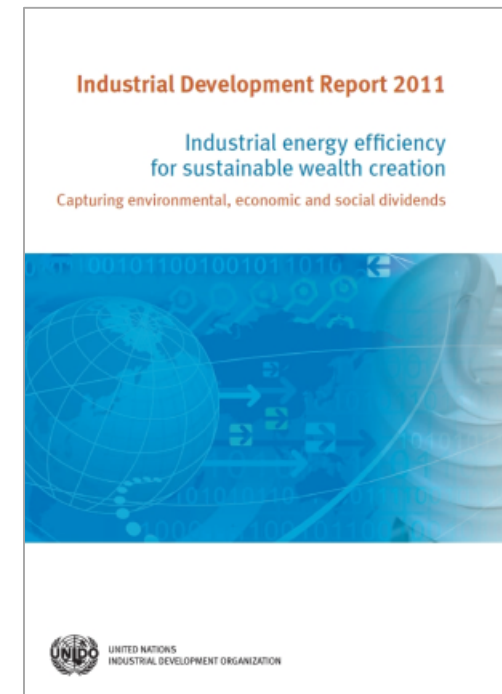
