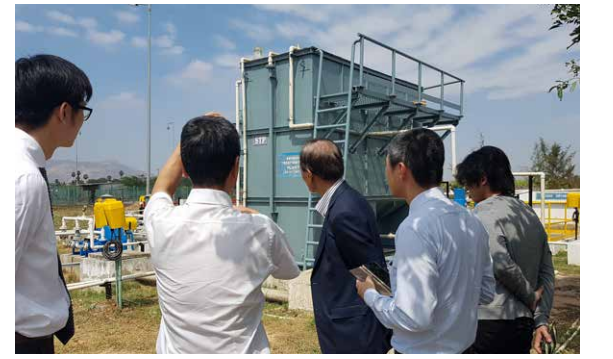


3. Technology Transfer
