Africa Advisory Programme: since 2013, experienced African investment promotion advisors have been posted to support Japanese companies interested in doing their businesses in Africa. The advisors are based at UNIDO field offices residing in Algeria, Ethiopia and Mozambique.

UNIDO ITPO Tokyo: African Advisors

- > UNIDO ITPO Tokyo Advisors cover 6 countries: Algeria, Burundi, Ethiopia, Mozambique, **Uganda and Rwanda**
- > Tailor-made assistance has been provided to more than 120 Japanese companies, which succeeded in concluding business agreements and establishing liaison offices.
- ➤ UNIDO ITPO Tokyo will assign one new advisor in West Africa in 2018.

Partnership case (1): Ethiopia

- > Fujifilm's first African office was opened in Addis Ababa in 2014, with the support of UNIDO ITPO Tokyo's advisor Mr. Tadesse.
- > Mr. Tadesse: 1) facilitated matching between Fujifilm and St. Paul's Millennium Hospital,
 - 2) provided coordination with various counterparts, and
 - 3) supported for local personnel recruitment.
- ➤ In 2017, Fujifilm established the Ethiopian Gastro-Intestinal Diagnostic Training Center with endoscopic equipment in collaboration with St. Paul's Millennium Hospital with the funds from the Government of Japan, and now dominates the market with more than 70% share.



















Partnership case (2): South Africa

- ➤ Mayekawa concluded business deal with Sir Fruit in South Africa to provide high-efficiency and low-carbon refrigeration system with heat recovery, under the UNIDO's "Low Carbon and Climate Resilient (LCCR) Industrial Development in Africa" project, based on the funds of Government of Japan.
- > UNIDO ITPO Tokyo facilitated the technology matching service between Mayekawa and Sir Fruit.





















Partnership case (3): Liberia

- ➤ Komatsu concluded partnership agreement with UNIDO to promote youth employment by supporting technical and vocational education, through the provision of heavy-duty construction equipment and training curriculum for unskilled operators, based on the funds of Government of Japan.
- The training is provided at the vocational center of **Booker Washington Institute** (Liberia's organization for human resource development) established under the UNIDO project.
